A one-time input by making a phone call and also sending a note.

The operator may need to reach for a tally sheet to count your input, as the operator will have received identical inputs from other callers.</i></p> <p>"Please support non-profit ... single-payer ... national health insurance ... via H.R. 676."</p> <p><i>pause slightly where indicated with ...</i></p>
Suggested Note to Send	<p>If you make any changes or additions to the following note, keep the note short, positive and polite.</p> <p>Dear Mr. President:</p> <p>Please encourage the U.S. Congress to pass legislation for Health Care for All with non-profit single-payer national health insurance, such as defined in H.R. 676. Non-profit financing of health care will stimulate the economy and keep our country great by recovering businesses, recovering and creating jobs, saving money, improving health and saving lives.</p> <p>A clear majority of Americans want the health care justice and the peace of mind from medical bills that people in other countries have experienced for decades that have been denied U.S. citizens for so very long.</p> <p>(include your name and address)</p>

<p>Send via U.S. Mail -- best option</p>	<p>Address the envelope. If you have number 10 envelope (4 1/8 by 9 1/2 inches), then use that. Put your return address on the envelope.</p> <p>President of the United States The White House 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue NW Washington, DC 20500</p> <p><i>Use an 8.5-inch x 11-inch standard full sheet of paper.</i></p> <p><i>At the top; write the date.</i></p> <p><i>At the bottom: Sign the letter.</i></p>
<p>Send via fax -- second best option</p> <p>-- at your computer at no cost</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to http://faxzero.com. Enter 2024562461 for the fax number and "President Obama" for the recipient name at "Receiver Information" at the right. Enter your name and your e-mail address at "Sender Information" on the left. 2. Copy the note above and paste it into the large text box at "Fax Information". Enter the "Confirmation Code" that you see on the screen exactly as you see it displayed. 3. Select "Send Free Fax Now". 4. You will receive an e-mail; you must select a link there to confirm your e-mail address before the fax is sent. 5. When the fax is sent, you will receive an additional e-mail.
