Health Care with the New Law

Costs still out of control (law signed Mar. 2010)

<p>Get more: excellent benefits Cover everyone for our entire lives, providing peace of mind and helping our poor life expectancy</p>	<p>Partial benefits Millions uninsured, not getting to the doctor ... continued unnecessary deaths from preventable diseases</p>
<p>Pay less: no premiums; no major bills due to excellent efficiency & least risk from all of us being in one public health insurance group \$83 and \$208 per month: two examples** of payroll health insurance tax Payroll tax for \$15,000 and \$50,000 yearly earned income.</p>	<p>Higher premiums, continued hardships, due to more regulations. over \$3,000 per month for a family: for health insurance premiums Actual experience of NY state where regulations were added.</p>
<p>Lower taxes from less government fewer government agencies, fewer government programs, fewer regulators</p>	<p>Higher taxes from more government more government agencies, more government programs, more regulators</p>
<p>Public agency with less bureaucracy influenced by us, the public</p>	<p>Continued bureaucracy influenced by corporate lobbyists</p>
<p>Choices of lifestyle & health care such as choice of profession, employer, job, leave of absence, early retirement, physicians and medical facilities</p>	<p>Government intrusions mandated health insurance plus government forcing people onto Medicaid and onto “estate recovery”</p>
<p>More jobs from globally competitive businesses</p>	<p>Fewer jobs including the impact of medical tourism</p>
